2006 Capital Improvements Program (CIP)
Status Report

1. Timber Creek Channel Project (Station 0+00 to 36+00)

Description..... This project consists of widening the channel of Timber Creek from its confluence with the Clear Fork Trinity River to a point approximately 3,600 feet upstream. The project also includes the enlargement and relocation of several water and sewer lines. The purpose of the project is to remove over 65 homes from the 100-year floodplain.

Status..... The project is complete.

2. Timber Creek Culvert at Winscott Road

Description..... This project consists of enlarging the Timber Creek culvert under Winscott Road to provide adequate capacity to carry the 100-year storm. Upon completion, the project will remove several homes from the 100-year floodplain.

Status..... The project is complete.

3. Plantation East Creek Drainage Improvements

Description..... This project consists of enlarging the Plantation East Creek channel between Tara Drive and Springbranch Drive to carry the remaining portion of the 100-year flood not contained by the underground box culvert. Upon completion, the project will remove several homes from the 100-year floodplain.

Status..... Engineering plans have been completed and easements have been acquired. This project has been changed from a gabion wall to a modular wall design. This necessitated acquiring additional subsurface easements for the tie backs. These have been acquired with the exception of one easement.

Estimated
Completion Date..... December 2009.

Estimated Cost..... \$1,200,000.

4. Plantation West Creek Drainage Improvements

Description..... This project consists of widening the channel of Plantation West Creek from its confluence with Mary's Creek upstream to a point north of the Mary's Creek Drive low water crossing. The purpose of the project is to contain the 100-year flood and prevent street flooding that is occurring in the vicinity of Twilight Park. This project will remove several homes from the 100-year floodplain.

Status..... Bids were received on January 31, 2007 and the project has been completed.

Final Construction
Cost..... \$2,050,472.48

5. Willow Bend Creek Channel Improvements

Description..... This project consists of lining a portion of Willow Bend Creek downstream of Llano Avenue. This project was combined with the Plantation West Creek project and has been completed.

6. Community Development Block Grant Project

Description..... The 33rd Year CDBG project consists of installing sidewalks on Usher Street, Wade Hampton Street, Warden Street, Park Center Street, and Cozby North Street. Funding is from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and the contract is administered by Tarrant County.

Status..... The project was bid on August 27, 2008 and is now completed.

Final Construction
Cost..... \$125,475.87
